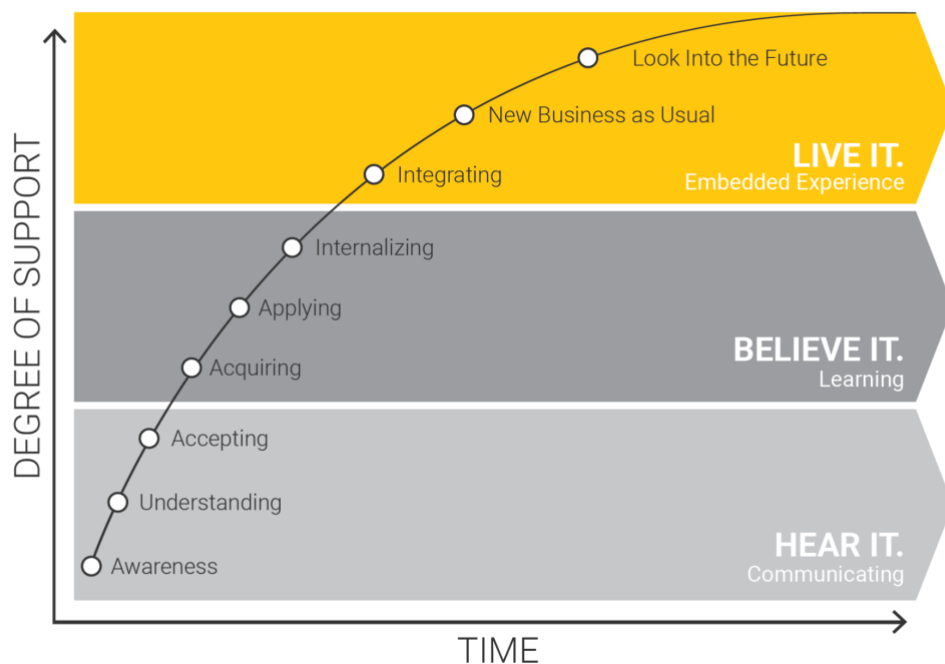


Social-Emotional Learning Action Guide
